DIOCESAN CONVENTION: The 39th Convention of the Diocese of WTN will be held by virtual teleconference on Nov 20, 1:00–4:00 PM. Several congregations throughout the Diocese have agreed to serve as host sites; our clergy and delegates will be assigned to a particular site. Only three essential items will be covered: (1) voting to fill diocesan offices/positions; (2) passage of 2021 budgets; and (3) an address by the Bishop. We have 3 delegates but need 5 total, plus a couple alternates. All registrations must be in by Oct 15, so please let us know as soon as possible if you would like to be a delegate or alternate delegate.
