EPIPHANY

In Western churches (including Episcopal), Epiphany celebrates the arrival of the Wise Men from the East to the Christ child in Bethlehem. For Eastern churches, this celebration mixes together both the visitation of the Wise Men and the Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan. Both of these are events that manifest or reveal the divinity of Christ to the wider world. In Eastern Churches, Epiphany is called "Theophany," which means the "shining forth" of God. An Epiphany prayer for your home: *Lord God of heaven and earth, you revealed your only-begotten Son to every nation by the guidance of a star. Bless this house and all who inhabit it. Fill us with the light of Christ, that our concern for others may reflect your love. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.*

2023 ALTAR FLOWER SIGN-UP

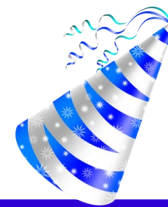
