In Western churches (including Episcopal), Epiphany celebrates the arrival of the Wise Men from the East to the Christ child in Bethlehem. Both of these are events that manifest or reveal the divinity of Christ to the wider world. In Eastern Churches, Epiphany is called "Theophany," which means the "shining forth" of God.
