MESSAGE FROM FR. JEFF

The word *fear* occurs in the RSV bible 363 times, *afraid* 157 more. Adam tells God, "We heard you in the garden and we were afraid, so we hid because we were naked." Fear of the Lord can be positive (meaning awe and respect), but in this case it is negative. It is a fear that separates us from God and one another. Psalm 8:4-5 speaks in highest terms of human value in the eyes of God: "what is man that you care for him? Yet you have made him little less than a god, and crowned him with glory and honor." Fear strips us of our God-given glory and diminishes us. Fearful people harm themselves and others. Hebrews 13:6 (quoting Psalm 118) declares: "The Lord is my help, I will not be afraid, what can man do to me?" This is a precious insight, but hard to live out. That is why "fear not" is a constant command. Jesus said, "fear is useless, what is needed is trust." Few of us have such trust.

Sometimes, it is hard for me to know the difference between godly trust and foolishness. Am I being brave, or am I just in denial? Am I living in faith, or am I putting God to the test? We need each other in the discerning, because the church is the place where "naked people" learn to trust the Lord and come out of hiding. In church we discover our worth and value. It is the training center where we live in His help and stop fearing everything else. The church is made up of slaves to fear being set free by their love and trust in a God who seeks only that they live and prosper in union with Him.

This is why we are going to move forward in faith as we return to the Healing Eucharist on Saturday nights. Jesus sent the church to heal and free people from the demonic powers. This is a ministry of faith and love. The OSL is a vital parish ministry, as is the DOK. The DOK will gather once each month (during summer, on Jul 6 and Aug 10) at the 3:00 PM Tuesday Evening Prayer/Holy Eucharist. Afterward, we will reflect on our prayer book as a means of spiritual growth. Both groups are important ministries in our church, and they welcome new members. It is vital that we be church together, even as we seek to be prudent about the virus. Please pray God's protection upon us and for the light of His wisdom as we seek to love and serve Him at Saint Andrew's.
