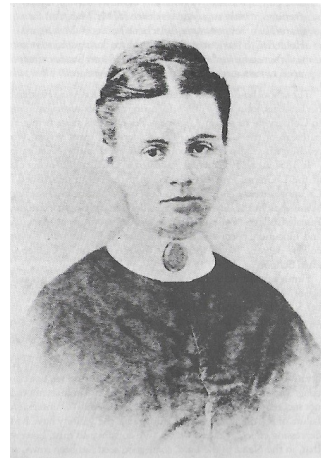

On Sept 8, 2022, the Chief Piomingo Chapter of the National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) will host a reception and brief presentation at the Morton Museum to honor the memory of Miss Anna Holden, a notable Woman in History who contributed greatly to her Collierville community (and who was the driving force behind the establishment of Saint

Andrew's). A "DAR Women in History" medal and certificate will be presented to Kate Renner, Director of the Morton Museum. This presentation follows the Morton Museum's Lunch & Learn with the Memphis Women's Legacy Trail from 12:00–12:45 PM.
