**OSL HEALING UNIVERSITY:** Healing University meets this Thursday, Sept 9, at 6:00 PM in the parish hall. This week's lesson is **Grace for Healing** taught by Barry Bennett. **2022 VESTRY ELECTION PROCESS:** Three vestry positions for 2022, each for a 3-year term, will be elected by the parish at our annual meeting in November. The nominating committee will soon be searching for volunteers who are willing to be nominees to serve Saint Andrew's in this very important capacity. **40th ANNUAL CONVENTION OF THE DIOCESE OF WEST TENNESSEE:** The Diocesan Convention will be on Friday, Nov 19, and will be held via virtual teleconference with 5 remote in-person sites (eg, Calvary, Holy Communion, St. John's – nothing too far away). If it's like last year, the day will most likely begin with a box lunch. Saint Andrew's is allowed to send five delegates in addition to our clergy – plus we need a couple of alternate delegates who can step in if a delegate encounters a conflict at the last moment. If any parish members would like to have this experience of representing Saint Andrew's at a Diocesan Convention, we encourage you to volunteer to be a delegate or an alternate delegate. Let the clergy or the church office know as soon as you can. Thank you!

**MEN'S MONDAY BIBLE STUDY:** The men's group will finish their study of Daniel on Monday, Sept 6. 
