Dear Parishioners and Friends,

During the Eucharistic Prayer each Sunday we are given an option to name those saints whom we hold especially dear. It is my practice to say Mary (the mother of Jesus and the mother of the church), Andrew (our patron), and Benedict. Why Benedict?

As a young man of faith, he lived in Italy at a time of severe social decline. His example drew others seeking a life of prayer and Christian civility. He called it a school for God's service. His rule provided stability in a chaotic time; renown for its moderation—neither too harsh nor too lenient—it was to shape the English for centuries. What we call the Anglican Way is Benedictine to its core.

Our parish mission statement is taken from St. Benedict: We identify as a Christian community focused on prayer, work, and study. We define work as in-reach and outreach. I was shaped and formed in a Benedictine seminary, much as the Anglican Church was. I have come to appreciate it at a much deeper level. The Benedictine spirituality is not exciting. It is quiet and unassuming. It is based on the daily office (they prayed seven times a day)—the work of prayer on behalf of the world. It is also the work of being shaped by the psalms and daily readings from books of the Bible.

For a very long time I have emphasized the Benedictine model. In the coming years, we will be more focused on its depth of riches. It is who we are and what we are called to be: Jesus centered, Scripture focused, community minded, and service oriented. I hope you will be open to learning from this great father of the church. I hope you will participate in our efforts to make Saint Andrew's a school for God's service.
