CONFIRMATION CELEBRATION LUNCHEON: In honor of our 2017 confirmands, the ECW is planning a special luncheon in the parish hall after the 10:30 AM confirmation service on Feb 19. The Bishop will be with us that day for his annual visit. Everyone is invited to attend the luncheon after the service, but you **HAVE** to sign up. Please sign your family up as soon as possible so that the ECW will know how many casseroles to make. Let's all join in celebrating our new confirmands.

UPCOMING EUCHARISTIC MINISTER TRAINING: Bill Corum will be leading EM training soon. Anyone who is interested in serving on the altar as EM should take this training session, after which you can be licensed as an EM. Also, current EMs are welcome to join the class for a refresher. Once Bill knows who all is interested, he can work out a date and time.

CHORAL EVENSONG AT ST. GEORGE'S: The Coventry Choir of St. George's Episcopal Church and the Motet Choir from Holy Communion Church will sing Evensong at St. George's Church on Feb 12 at 5:30–7:00 PM. Music will be by Howells, Ayleward, Palestrina, and Eccard, with the Psalm 46 setting by Martin Luther. The choirs are under the direction of Angela Gill Saunders, Director of Music at St. George's and David Ouzts, Minister of Music and Liturgy at Holy Communion Church, with accompaniment by Jane Gamble, Assistant Minister of Music. St. George's Friends of Music will host the service, and a reception will follow the service in Sturni Hall. All are welcome to this quintessentially Anglican service.

ADULT CHRISTIAN EDUCATION: Fr. David leads our Adult Christian Education program on Wednesdays at 10:00 AM. Currently, we are studying the Nicene Creed. Next, we will study the Beatitudes. From a Latin root that means "blessed" or "happy," the Beatitudes are statements in the New Testament that begin with a similar form: "Blessed are . . . , for. . . ." The Beatitudes at the beginning of the Sermon on the Mount in the Gospel of Matthew and in the Sermon on the Plain in Luke are spoken by Jesus to his disciples. For our study, we will read *Beatitudes from the Back Side* by J. Ellsworth Kalas (1923–2015). Kalas was a United Methodist pastor for 38 years before joining the faculty at Asbury Theological Seminary in Wilmore, Kentucky. A sign-up sheet to order the book is posted in the parish hall.
