**NEW LADIES' BIBLE STUDY:** On March 21, the Ladies' Bible Study group will begin a 5-week study on *The Prodigal God: Recovering the Heart of the Christian Faith*, by Timothy Keller.

**NEW MEN'S BIBLE STUDY:** Fr. David will lead a Men's Bible Study on Tuesdays at 10:00 AM in the conference room. For their study, they will read the Gospel According to John and the Johannine Letters, using a volume in the New Collegeville Bible Commentary series by Scott M.
