The reading of Holy Scripture has served as a foundation for the Daily Office since its creation. Participation in the Daily Office is an essential part of Anglican spirituality. The principle function of Morning Prayer is the worship of God at daybreak. At Evening Prayer, we offer praise and thanks to God for the day that is past. The readings for the Daily Office can be found on pages 933–1001 of the 1979 American Book of Common Prayer. **BABY CHANGING STATIONS:** Saint Andrew's now has changing tables installed in both the Men's and Ladies' rooms in the parish hall. We hope these will be helpful and convenient for families with small children. The stations are designed to hold up to 250 pounds and thus should be very safe.
