JANUARY FELLOWSHIP GATHERING: There is a fellowship event on Friday, Jan 26, in the parish hall. A brief social time at 5:30 PM will be followed by Evening Prayer at 6:00 PM and then by dinner, which will be provided. Childcare will be provided for all ages for parents attending this event. Nursery-aged children (6 and under) will be in the nursery, and older children will be supervised in the room next to the nursery. Older children please bring games. COLLIERVILLE FOOD PANTRY: On Thursdays in January, Saint Andrew's volunteers take whatever items have been donated by the parish over to the Food Pantry and work there from 9–11 AM. If parishioners wish to donate items, mark them "for Food Pantry" and place them on the kitchen table. The pantry always needs canned meat items (including stews and soups), cereals, beans, tuna, peanut butter, jelly, bath tissue, travel soaps and shampoos, and brown paper grocery bags.

UPDATE ON BISHOP SEARCH AND TRANSITION PROCESS: The Search Committee has begun their work of listening to the people of The Episcopal Diocese of West Tennessee so as to develop an accurate profile of our Diocese. This is a vital step in discerning the qualities and gifts we are seeking for our next Bishop, and the Search Committee wants as much data as they can gather. The first way they will gather data will be through a detailed online survey about the Diocese and our hopes for our next Bishop. The survey will take about 30 minutes to complete and must be completed in a single session. We hope you will set aside half an hour to share your perspective.
