COLLIERVILLE FOOD PANTRY: On Thursdays in January, Saint Andrew's volunteers take whatever items have been donated by the parish over to the Food Pantry and work there from 9–11 AM. If parishioners wish to donate items, mark them "for Food Pantry" and place them on the kitchen table. The pantry always needs canned meat items (including stews and soups), cereals, beans, tuna, peanut butter, jelly, bath tissue, travel soaps and shampoos, and brown paper grocery bags.

The first way they will gather data will be through a detailed online survey about the Diocese and our hopes for our next Bishop.
