NEW EXHIBITION AT THE BIBLE MUSEUM ON THE SQUARE: A new exhibition, *Generations of Faith*, is now open at the museum. This exhibition celebrates the faith legacy of our community through a collection of faith artifacts loaned to the museum by members of the community, including a number of historical items from Saint Andrew's. Historical family Bibles, Books of Prayer, and photos will tell the ongoing story of how faith has been transmitted from generation to generation.
