This is a vital step in discerning the qualities and gifts we are seeking for our next Bishop, and the Search Committee wants as much data as they can gather. The first way they will gather data will be through a detailed online survey about the Diocese and our hopes for our next Bishop. The survey will take about 30 minutes to complete and must be completed in a single session. The survey completion deadline is Feb. 28.
