THANK YOU: The EYC gives a big THANK-YOU to the Saint Andrew's parish family for your donations towards "Souper Bowl Sunday." Thanks to your generous donations, we were able to collect \$729.25 for the Collierville Food Pantry. This money will be used during the year to purchase food for the Pantry – they prefer that we do the shopping instead of giving them the monetary donation, so we usually take them two large deliveries during the year, usually during Saint Andrew's months to volunteer at the Food Pantry.

NEW EXHIBITION AT THE BIBLE MUSEUM ON THE SQUARE: A new exhibition, *Generations of Faith*, is now open at the museum. This exhibition celebrates the faith legacy of our community through a collection of faith artifacts loaned to the museum by members of the community, including a number of historical items from Saint Andrew's. Historical family Bibles, Books of Prayer, and photos will tell the ongoing story of how faith has been transmitted from generation to generation. The museum is open Tuesdays through Saturdays, 10 AM to 5 PM. Admission is \$5 per person or \$15 for a family of 3–5. Group rates are available.
