SUNDAY EVENING BIBLE STUDY: The Sunday evening study group will have a one-week session in the conference room on Apr 22 at 6:30 PM entitled "An Examination of Biblical Proof for the Resurrection of Jesus." Everything we believe about the life, teachings, and significance of Jesus of Nazareth hinges on our view of the resurrection accounts. The resurrection account in the gospels is the most compelling evidence for the deity of Jesus. This teaching offers a survey of the evidence presented in support of the eyewitness accounts. This session will be a good lead-in to the program "The Case for Faith," which will begin on Sunday, Apr 29, and run for six weeks. This video program is based on the book *The Case for Faith*, written by former atheist Lee Strobel, and addresses the hard questions while addressing the most common objections to the Christian faith.
