We are grateful that **Jean Woods** has graciously volunteered to be our new scheduler. Jean needs to know by the 15th of each month if you will not be available for the next month plus one week. After the 15th, she coordinates all the information and finalizes the schedule. If you contact her after the 15th, she may not be able to incorporate your request. After the schedule is finalized, if you cannot serve on a particular date, please arrange for a substitute and notify Cynthia in the church office.

SERVICE PARTICIPANTS ARE NEEDED: All our volunteers who have signed up to be service participants are much appreciated. We could not function properly without all the volunteer participants. With the number of services we have, though, we still need more people to volunteer so that the duties can be spread out amongst a larger group. Some individuals are having to serve almost every week and at more than one service per week. If you feel a calling to serve on the altar, let the church office know. We need Eucharistic Ministers and Acolytes for all service times, and we always need Torch Bearers and Ushers (especially Saturday ushers). The 10:30 service is our largest service, but the participation in the various service roles is lightest for that service time. We hope a few individuals will feel called to help out in each of these roles. It would make big difference. Thank you.
