COLLIERVILLE FOOD PANTRY: On Thursdays in August, Saint Andrew's volunteers take whatever items have been donated by the parish over to the Food Pantry and work there from 9–11 AM. If parishioners wish to donate items, mark them "for Food Pantry" and place them on the kitchen table. The pantry always needs canned meat items (including stews and soups), cereals, beans, tuna, peanut butter, jelly, bath tissue, travel soaps and shampoos, and brown paper grocery bags. Volunteers please sign up on the bulletin board in the parish hall.

WHEN YOU OR A LOVED ONE IS ILL: We desire to be of assistance when parishioners are in need. We ask that you or a family member contact the church office to say whether one or more of the following is desired: to be placed on the church and/or DOK prayer lists; to be visited by the priest or a member of OSL; to receive communion at home or in the hospital; or to be contacted by a pastoral care team for a meal or transportation. STYROFOAM PRODUCTS IN THE CHURCH: Several years ago, it was decided that Saint Andrew's would not buy or use Styrofoam products. For years the stuff did not appear here, but in the last year or so, Styrofoam cups, bowls, plates, etc., have been appearing in the pantry. The pantry is stocked by the staff with non-Styrofoam products from Costco. If parishioners need to buy products for an event, please do not buy Styrofoam and then store the leftovers in the church pantry. They will be removed.
