**COMMUNITY PROJECT IN HONOR OF MIFA'S JUBILEE YEAR:** On Sept 15, from 8:30 AM to 12:00 PM, Saint Andrew's is partnering with Epiphany Lutheran Church to commemorate MIFA's Jubilee Year! We will be working in their community garden located off Wolf River Blvd to help with harvesting, weeding, and planting. All of the produce is donated to Collierville Food Pantry! For the event: No shorts. Wear sturdy/old shoes,

bug spray, and sunscreen. Bring a towel, gloves, and a labeled shovel and/or clippers. Children are welcome – there will be jobs for all ages. There will be shaded areas and picnic tables. Water, snacks, paper towels/wet wipes will be provided. There will also be a birthday cake! The Community Garden is located near the corner of Wolf River Blvd and Bray Station. For event parking, they request that folks carpool to save space. Drivers can pull directly onto the grass at the Community Garden space. There will be people directing the cars, depending on how wet the ground is. If the ground is really soggy, they will ask everyone to park on the street adjacent to the garden site, off Bray Station.
