## CHURCH MUSINGS

"Alzheimer's (metaphorically) is the spiritual sickness of our day. We have forgotten who we are." This is a quote from our very own Fr. Jeff Marx although it is taken from my own memory, which I confess is not as good as it once was, but the general idea I believe is accurate. But my own memory. Oh vey! One of the worst lies I tell myself is "I don't need to write this down because I'll remember it." Maybe some of you can identify with this.

But the reality of this spiritual disease is profound, and because we are not always very good at our "coping skills," which are reading the scriptures (learning and listening), praying (relationship), and journaling (so we can remember later), we often forget that we are beloved children of God. The end result in our lives is lack of trust in our Lord, which leads to busyness, exhaustion, and anxiety—the antithesis of peace and joy and life in the kingdom.

So I end with two thoughts: One is that we resist the urge towards identity politics unless it is to identify exclusively with our Lord as His beloved children. He is out for our good, He is the perfect parent, and we are deeply loved. His desire is for life abundant, not necessarily the perfect life as defined by us, but the abundance that only He can give as we surrender our need to define and control our own destinies. He is our only hope in a world tumbling towards chaos and despair.

The second thought is that, although I have been speaking about Alzheimer's in a metaphorical way, it is a disease that has a very real physical presence and has devastated families and lives in very real and tragic ways. It is one of the greatest tragedies of our age and one of the reasons that Saint Andrew's supports Page Robbins Adult Day Care Center here in Collierville. If you know someone with this terrible disease, REMEMBER to pray for them and their caregivers. Every day must feel like a 72-hour day to them. And if you have the opportunity to attend the annual Gala to support their ministry to families who have loved ones with this disease, please be generous with your resources.

And finally, I want to leave you with a quote written on the wall of the 9/11 memorial in NYC, that you might remember the blessings of the knowledge that you are deeply loved and are important children of God:

*"No day shall erase you from the memory of time."*
