GENERAL ANNOUNCEMENTS

INQUIRERS' CLASS: The annual Inquirers' Class is now in progress across four Sundays (Jan 13 & 27 and Feb 3 & 10) at 9:30 AM in the conference room. Fr. Jeff is leading the class. Those who complete all sessions may then participate in the sacramental rite of Confirmation, Reception into the Episcopal Church, or Reaffirmation of Baptismal Vows with Bishop Johnson at Saint Andrew's on Mar 3. Those who would like to sit in but don't necessarily wish to be confirmed or received are also welcome in the class.

COLLIERVILLE FOOD PANTRY: On Thursdays in January (the 24th and 31st remain), Saint Andrew's volunteers take whatever items have been donated by the parish over to the Food Pantry and work there from 9–11 AM. If parishioners wish to donate items, mark the items "For Food Pantry" and place them on the kitchen table. The Food Pantry always needs canned meat items (including stews and soups), cereals, beans, tuna, peanut butter, jelly, bath tissue, travel soaps and shampoos, and brown paper grocery bags. Two volunteers are still needed for Jan 31.

SUNDAY EVENING BIBLE STUDY: The Sunday evening study group has begun a study of the Gospel of Matthew. They meet in the conference room at 6:30 PM. They always welcome new members as they explore the Bible together.

LADIES' BIBLE STUDY: The ladies' study group has begun a new video study of "Twelve More Women of the Bible: Life-Changing Stories for Women Today." This video study features 6 speakers. All parish ladies are welcome to join in the study. They meet in the parish hall every Tuesday, and they would love to have new members join them.

TUESDAY MEN'S BIBLE STUDY: The Tuesday men's study group is continuing their investigation of the books of Kings. They welcome new members to come and explore the Bible with them. They meet every Tuesday morning at 10:00 AM in the conference room.

THURSDAY MORNING BIBLE STUDY WITH FR. JOSEPH: Ever wonder how an apocalyptic Jewish cult became the largest religion in the world? Or how three words divided Christianity in 1054?
