GENERAL ANNOUNCEMENTS

INQUIRERS' CLASS: The annual Inquirers' Class will be held on four Sundays (Jan 13 & 27 and Feb 3 & 10) at 9:30 AM in the conference room. Fr. Jeff will lead the class. Those who complete the class may then participate in the sacramental rite of Confirmation, Reception into the Episcopal Church, or Reaffirmation of Baptismal Vows with Bishop Johnson at Saint Andrew's on Mar 3. Everyone is welcome to join the class whether they wish to be confirmed/received or not. If you are interested, please call the church office or sign up on the bulletin board in the parish hall.

COLLIERVILLE FOOD PANTRY: On Thursdays in January (10, 17, 24, and 31), Saint Andrew's volunteers take whatever items have been donated by the parish over to the Food Pantry and work there from 9–11 AM. If parishioners wish to donate items, mark the items "For Food Pantry" and place them on the kitchen table. The Food Pantry always needs canned meat items (including stews and soups), cereals, beans, tuna, peanut butter, jelly, bath tissue, travel soaps and shampoos, and brown paper grocery bags.
