COLLIERVILLE FOOD PANTRY: On Thursdays in August, Saint Andrew's volunteers take whatever items have been donated by the parish over to the Food Pantry and work there from 9–11 AM. If parishioners wish to donate items, mark them "For Food Pantry" and place them on the kitchen table. The pantry always needs canned meat items (including stews and soups), cereals, beans, tuna, peanut butter, jelly, bath tissue, travel soaps and shampoos, and brown paper grocery bags. All the volunteer slots have been filled. Thank you.
